

#406 Design Workshop

This is a fun and creative workshop where I inspire you to design your un-quilted tops and get you out of your box! During the morning lecture I teach you how to pick the perfect designs for your quilt tops, working with the “creatively pieced” top, designing whole cloth quilts, how to use your stencils and making those borders fit. We also discuss threads and batting. The afternoon is devoted to designing and marking your tops.

If you have no unquilted tops to mark, please bring 1-2 yards of solid or tone-on-tone yardage (or even a vintage linen tablecloth ☺) and you will be able to design a whole cloth quilt!

THINGS TO BRING:

Quilt Tops – several ☺

Vintage Linens for whole-cloth quilts *(Optional)*

Fabric Yardage for whole cloth quilts *(Optional)*

Scissors

Rulers

Marking Pens, bring several! (Recommended: Mark-B-Gone, Stabilo white pencil or Clover white pen)

Most students find they are so busy marking their quilts they never get the chance to actually sew. **Bringing your sewing machine is optional.**
