

Quilt Camp in The Desert

#101 Razzle Dazzle

Finished Size: 55" x 71"

Finished Block Size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

In this quilt, warm and cool colors mix together to create kaleidoscope blocks. It's fast and easy and every block yields a surprise!

FABRIC TIP:

I chose a variety of warm and cool colored prints for this quilt. Since most are tone-on-tone, they appear as solids from a distance.

SUPPLIES:

Suggested Book: *New Cuts for New Quilts!* By Karla Alexander

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

Several pieces of blank paper

Safety pin

9 1/2" x 9 1/2" acrylic square ruler

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall

Fabric:

1 1/4 yards of blue for border

3/4 yard of black and white check for sashing and inner border

1/3 yard EACH of 8 different warm colors to total 8 (for example yellows, oranges, and pinks) for the blocks

1/3 yard EACH of 8 different cool colors to total 8 (for example blues, turquoises, greens) for the blocks and cornerstones

5/8 yard for binding

3 1/2 yards for backing

PLEASE PRE-CUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS PRIOR TO CLASS

CUTTING FOR BLOCKS:

From each of the warm AND cool colored fabric for the blocks, cut:

1 strip, 8" x 42"; crosscut into 3 rectangles, 8" x 11 1/2" (48 total)
