Supply List

Supply Fee: \$15. Will include some fabrics, threads, extra patterns and more plus surprises.

1. Set of small flat edge and Phillips screwdrivers (I will have some to buy if you cannot find this). They can be found in Hardware Stores and come in small plastic cases.

2. Avery's glue stick (orange, yellow, pink package) 2-3.

3. Sharp small scissors for cutting paper, Sharp small fabric scissors.

4. Roxanne's "Glue-Baste-it" or "Quilter's Choice" or other fabric basting glue. These are washable glues...

5. Permanent Fabric glue...Aleene's "Its OK to Wash it", or "Jewel it" are two good Permanent glues.

6. Small acrylic or plastic cutting board...Rotary Cutter boards are too porous, better to use a piece of plastic. You need a piece that is at least 8 x 11...A large plastic lid will also work...I buy cheap bread boards or cutting boards at the 99 cent store or at flea markets.

7. Small plastic cup for water.

8. Baby Wipes or wipes to clean hands and boards.

9. Basic sewing box supplies...pins, thimbles, needles (Clover Appliqué Gold Eye size 10 are great) and other tools in your basket.

10. Bright Solids, batiks or textured prints that read as solid fabrics in your color choices for the Molas. Don't forget greens, golds, oranges, yellow, and rich reds and vivid pinks and aqua. Think bright, and bring lots of tropical colors for birds and flowers. Also bring unusual background prints and solids to audition (Fat quarters are big enough, this is just to play around). There will be some fabrics in your kit along with some special thread.

11. Assorted threads to match fabrics.

12. Pens or pencils to take notes.

Optional: Small iron (only a very few irons can be used in the classroom) and pressing board, toothpicks (big ones!).
