

## Yardage: The More Scraps the Better!

### SCRAPPY STAR QUILT

#### 18 Blocks

Approximate finished size 63" x 79"

Blocks, Lattice, Cornerstones & Piano Key Border:

scraps or minimum of 18 fat quarters

Center:  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd or fat quarter

Background:  $2\frac{1}{4}$  yds

Binding:  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd

Backing: 4 yds

Batting: 67" x 83"

### SCRAPPY STAR MINIATURE WALL HANGING

#### 25 Blocks

Approximate finished size 48" x 48"

Blocks, Lattice, & Cornerstones: scraps or (25)  $\frac{1}{8}$  yd pieces

Center:  $\frac{1}{8}$  yd

Background #1:  $\frac{3}{4}$  yd

Background #2:  $\frac{5}{8}$  yd

1st Border:  $\frac{3}{8}$  yd

2nd Border:  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd

3rd Border:  $\frac{3}{4}$  yd

Binding:  $\frac{3}{8}$  yd

Backing: 3 yds

Batting: 52" x 52"

**Please note:** Yardage is for the design pictured on the front. If you want to make a piano key border, measurements are given along with the sewing instructions. Cut border from scrap fabrics.

## Cutting Instructions

### QUILT (63" x 79")

Cut **Center Square Fabric** into:

(2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips; then into (18)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Cut **Each Scrap Fabric** into:

(1)  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " square for small triangles

(2)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares for large triangles

(2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for cornerstones

(3)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for lattice

Save remainder of fabric for piano key border.

Cut **Background Fabric** into:

(3)  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " x 42" strips; then into (18)  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

(5)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips; then into (72)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

(2) 18" x 42" strips; then into:

(3) 18" squares for side triangles

(2)  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for corner triangles

Cut **Binding Fabric** into: (7) 2" x 42" strips

### MINIATURE WALL HANGING (48" x 48")

Cut **Center Square Fabric** into:

(1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strip; then into (25)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Cut **Each Scrap Fabric** into:

(1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square for small triangles

(2)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares for large triangles

(3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for cornerstones

(3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for lattice

Save remainder of fabric for border.

Cut **Background Fabric #1** into:

(3)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips; then into (25)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

(4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips; then into (100)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Cut **Background Fabric #2** into:

(3) 11" squares for side triangles

(2) 6" squares for corner triangles

Cut **Border Fabric #1** into: (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips

Cut **Border Fabric #2** into: (4)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42" strips

Cut **Border Fabric #3** into: (5)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips

Cut **Binding Fabric** into: (5) 2" x 42" strips

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
